

And thank you to the Robinson family for their donation of another bench to the school.

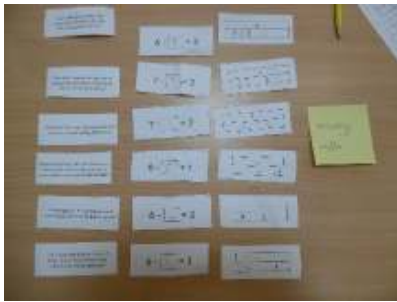
Also, don't forget your 100 club numbers, payments and renewals are now due and you can take your payment into the Post Office in Kettlewell.

News from Class One

In literacy this week we have been reading 'The Train Ride' by June Crebbin. We have been looking at the repeated pattern of the text and then we have been writing our own versions of the story. In phonics, we have been focusing on our tricky words and looked at some songs on YouTube which we enjoyed. In maths the Year Ones and Twos have continued to work on addition and subtraction. We



have been using lots of different methods to help us solve problems.

Connie and Paige have been learning all about weights. They have compared different objects and have been working out which objects are heavier than others.



In our topic work we have learnt about the history of the railways. We learnt about George Stephenson and his famous steam train 'The Rocket.' In science we have learnt about friction and did some practical work based on this. We had fun testing the trains on different materials and even more fun making and testing our 'friction frogs!'
