External evidence;

- Sainsbury's Bronze award received. (Not silver as we can't do in school matches.)
- North Yorkshire's Children' and Young People's Health and Wellbeing survey 2016
 - *100 % of children enjoy Physical activity 90% enjoying it quite a lot or more.*
 - *60% say they do 5 or more hours of physical activity per week with 78% saying that they had exercised 5 or more times in the previous week.*
 - *We have several pupils who exceed in their chosen sport outside of school.*
